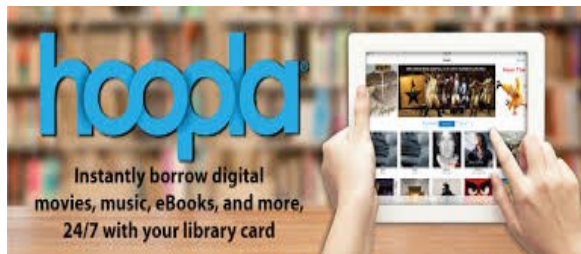

Titles can be enjoyed immediately or transferred to a variety of devices, including iPod®, Sony® Reader™, and many others. Titles will automatically expire at the end of the lending period. There are no late fees!

Before using you must download the app which is a button on the homepage.

- Go to the library website and click on the “Browse” tab at the top
- Select “Online catalog”
- Log in in the upper right-hand corner using your library card number and the phone number you used to register for your library card
- Scroll down to Electronic Resources and click on the OverDrive link.

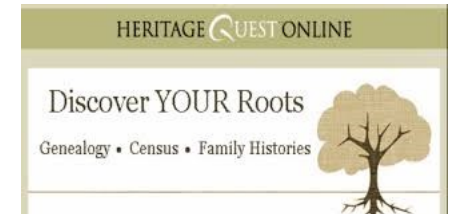
